



I-215 WIDENING PROJECT

Full Nighttime Closures I-215 and SR-259

February 24 to February 28

Nighttime Full I-215 and SR-259 Closures

As part of the I-215 Widening Project, construction crews are scheduled to **close northbound and southbound I-215 and SR-259 nightly in San Bernardino Sunday, February 24 through Thursday, February 28**. Northbound and southbound I-215 and SR-259 will close at **9:00 p.m. nightly and re-open to motorists at 5:00 a.m.**

The closure is necessary to allow crews to remove a temporary bridge structure at the 16th Street Bridge. This is the tallest bridge on the project at more than 60 feet high and measures 650 feet in length.

Turn-by-turn detours:

To Northbound I-215: Exit Baseline Street and turn left, turn right on Mt. Vernon Ave. and travel north to access northbound I-215 using the on-ramp

To Southbound I-215: Exit 27th Street/Mt. Vernon Avenue and turn right, travel south on Mt. Vernon Avenue, turn left on 5th Street and turn right to access the southbound I-215 on-ramp

To Northbound SR-259: Exit Baseline Street and turn right, turn left on H Street, turn left on Highland Avenue and enter SR-259 using the on-ramp

To Southbound SR-259: Exit Highland Avenue and turn right, turn left on Mt. Vernon Avenue and travel south, turn left on 5th Street and enter southbound I-215
