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EMERGENCY closure of westbound I-10 in Fontana to replace steel beam hit at Citrus Ave Interchange

FONTANA, CA – San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG), the California Department of Transportation, and the City of Fontana, will close all lanes of westbound Interstate 10 in Fontana tonight, April 5, from midnight to 4am Saturday morning to safely replace a steel beam that was hit on April 4 by a truck transporting heavy equipment.

The full closure of the westbound lanes are necessary for the safety of both the construction crews and the motoring public. Traffic will be detoured off the freeway at Sierra Avenue and use Valley Boulevard to continue west to Cherry Avenue to reconnect with westbound Interstate 10.

Yesterday's bridge hit resulted in a 3+ hour closure of westbound interstate 10. Crews were mobilized and restored safety and opened up the freeway to traffic by 7:30 pm. Construction of the new Citrus Avenue Interchange is expected to resume on schedule following tonight's emergency closure. Construction of the new interchange began in April 2012 and is expected to continue through the end of 2014.
