


PLAN AHEAD: TWO FULL OFF-RAMP CLOSURES COMING SOON

Loma Linda, CA – As part of the I-10 Tippecanoe Interchange Improvement Project, Phase I, construction crews will be conducting **Two Full Closures** of the Eastbound I-10 Tippecanoe Ave./ Anderson St. off-ramp. Construction activities will include removal of AC, excavating, potholing for underground utilities, placement of base material, concrete pour, stripe and delineate and relocation of k-rail. These full closures are needed to ensure the safety of the traveling public and the workers.

The first full closure will begin **Friday, November 22, 2013 at 10:00 PM** and will conclude **Monday, November 25, 2013 at 6:00 AM**. The second full closure will take place on **Saturday, December 21, 2013 from 7:00 AM to 11:00 PM**.
