


Interstate 10 Westbound Widening Yucaipa to Redlands



Construction will start soon for a new lane on westbound Interstate 10 between Yucaipa and Redlands. This project will add a general purpose lane to approximately 3.5 miles of westbound I-10, between Live Oak Canyon Road in Yucaipa and Ford Street in Redlands.

The project will pave the way for better traffic flow, especially for morning commuters headed "down the hill" to San Bernardino and other points west. Construction is expected to start in early 2011 and take slightly more than two years to complete. Project features include:

- Placement of meters at westbound Yucaipa Boulevard on-ramp to regulate traffic operations
- Cutback of the slope and construction of a retaining wall north of the freeway between Yucaipa Boulevard and Wabash Avenue



Anticipated Construction Schedule

- ☐ Start: Early 2011
- ☐ Complete: Spring 2013


SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE The safety of crews and motorists is the highest priority for SANBAG and Caltrans during this project. Follow these safety tips near the I-10 construction zone:

- ☐ Slow down and watch for workers and equipment.
- ☐ Remember that traffic fines are doubled in construction zones.
- ☐ Allow extra time to get to work, school or other appointments.
- ☐ Be extra careful when driving at night and in rainy weather.
- ☐ Avoid distractions, such as mobile phones, in this area.
- ☐ Watch for occasional ramp or lane closures.
- ☐ Be patient. Remember that this is a short-term inconvenience for a long-term solution to traffic congestion.

Project Costs, Funding

SANBAG has acquired funding for this \$26.2 million project from a combination of federal, state and local sources:

- **Federal Surface Transportation Program, \$7.8 million**
- **Prop 1B Corridor Mobility Improvement Account, \$14.1 million**
- **State Highway Operation & Protection Program, \$.7 million**
- **Measure I, \$3.6 million**
