

# I-10/TIPPECANOE INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

## PHASE I



### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The San Bernardino Associated Governments (SANBAG), and its partner agencies, has designed major improvements to the Interstate 10 (I-10) and Tippecanoe Avenue interchange. The project traverses the cities of San Bernardino and Loma Linda. The magnitude and complexity of the project warrants the project to be built in two phases. The Phase I construction period is from August 2012 through summer 2013. Phase II is expected to begin construction in the fall of 2013. The project was initiated to improve access to key destinations including Loma Linda University Medical Center and local businesses, relieve traffic congestion, reduce impacts to local property owners and residents, and to build a sound project that is fiscally responsible.

### PROJECT FUNDING

Funds were secured to design, construct the interchange and provide local street improvements for both phases of the project. The total project cost is approximately \$70.5 million.

Phase I construction costs are estimated at \$16.5 million and are made up of the following funding sources:

- Federal funds ..... \$ 3.5 million
- State funds ..... \$10.0 million
- Local funds ..... \$ 3.0 million

Local funds include contributions from the Cities of Loma Linda and San Bernardino, as well as funds from the Inland Valley Development Agency.


**Project Approval & Environmental Document:** January 2011  
**Phases Identified:** April 2011

**Begin Construction:** August 2012  
**Anticipated End of Construction:** April 2014

#### PHASE I ACTIVITIES:

- » Widen the freeway eastbound off-ramp to a two-lane exit, expanding to four lanes at the intersection
- » Addition of an eastbound auxiliary lane
- » Widening of the south end of the San Timoteo Creek Bridge
- » Replacing the open channel with a reinforced concrete channel
- » Construction of several retaining walls
- » Construction of the drainage system
- » Replacement of eastbound and westbound guard rails on the San Timoteo Creek Bridge
- » Electrical work, including modification of signals adjacent to the eastbound off-ramp at Tippecanoe Ave.
- » Landscaping on both sides of the eastbound Tippecanoe Ave. off-ramp
